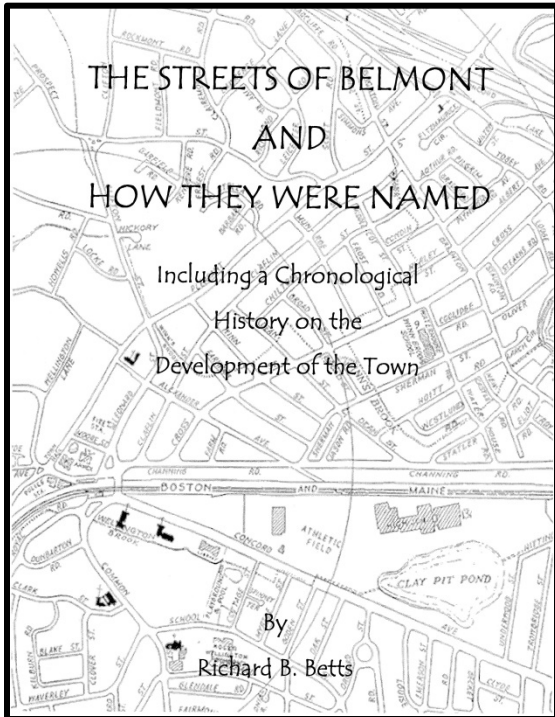


THE STREETS OF BELMONT AND HOW THEY WERE NAMED
