## Belmont Historical Society Historic House Plaque Program Application Form

To recognize the historic structures in our town the Belmont Historical Society establishes a historic house plaque program enabling property owners to purchase plaques that identify the historic name and construction date of their historic home. Property owners interested in participating in the historic house plaque program must complete and submit an application form.

Houses included in the inventory of historic resources kept by the Massachusetts Historical Commission are eligible if they retain integrity of original construction. Buildings not included in the inventory may be eligible if they are at least 50 years old, retain integrity of original construction, and a chain of title summary documenting the ownership history of the property is included with the application form.

Plaques will be distributed twice every year at the Belmont Historical Society's annual meeting in May, and in December.
